YOUTH ORCHESTRA, CYCNY 紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團



紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團今夏完成其第七次亞洲旅行巡迴演奏,與臺灣新北市大豐國小管弦樂團共同演出音樂會於日本和台灣,以及就地旅遊。紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團,成立於1996年,自1997年向紐約州政府註册爲非營利機構, 1998-2007年列入紐約市政府燈塔計劃(The Beacon Program)。1999年起至今多次獲得紐約市皇后藝術基金協會(Queens Council on the Arts)頒發: 紐約州藝術基金協會(New York State Council on the Arts)、紐約市文化事務局(New York City Department of Cultural Affairs)獎助基金及JP MorganChase銀行獎助基金;並獲紐約臺北經濟文化辦事處、臺北文化中 心以及紐約華僑文敎中心支持。自1998年以來,紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團所推出的《聖誕音樂會Holiday Concert》成 爲皇后區聖誕佳節傳統慶典之一。

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團秉持著「服務社區‧敎育英才」和「幼吾幼以及人之幼」的理念,成立以來,在社區中多次 親善演出,行跡遍及圖書館、公園、學校、耆老與復健中心、佛光山鹿野苑和台灣會館等。除每年定期於皇后區舉辦 的聖誕音樂會與林肯中心年度音樂會之外,曾舉辦七次美亞巡迴(1997、1999、2002、2005、2007、2010、2012)、兩 次美國西岸(1998.2000)以及一次歐洲(2006)演奏之旅,於舊金山、洛杉磯、聖地牙哥、夏威夷、臺北、宜蘭、台中、 鹿港、高雄、金門、廈門、北京、上海、香港、大阪、維也納、薩爾斯堡、布拉格等地,舉辦過數十場親善交流音樂 會,不僅開拓了團員們的視野,也達到音樂交流的使命。

樂團團員年紀為10-18歲,來自每年九月與一月兩次甄試,經錄取後,十月至六月之每週六下午一時至四時,假皇后區 貝158初中(Marie Curie Middle School)排練。由多位資優指導老師敎學,包括梁兆豐/音樂總監、鍾啓仁/指揮及弦樂、 林季靜/打擊樂、張若葳/管樂、張紀葳/譜務及木管等。

紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團每年舉行兩次大型音樂會,並經常赴社區醫院或老人院慈善演出;明年五月二十五日將於林 肯中心愛麗斯特莉廳(Alice Tully Hall)演出。

The Youth Orchestra is a Queens-based Youth Orchestra since 1996. The orchestra holds its open audition in the fall for new members; it meets for rehearsal on each Saturday from 1-4 PM, at MS 158 in Bayside, Queens, from October to June. Our excellent faculty members are: Jeffrey Liang, music director; ChiJen Christopher Chung, conductor & string; Chi-Ching Grace Lin, percussion; Lovell Chang, wind & brass; Chiwei Chang, wind & Librarian.

The orchestra presents two formal concerts annually. One free Holiday Concert for the community during holiday season in Queens; and one Annual Concert at Lincoln Center in spring. The orchestra also performs concerts for community service at nursing homes. In some summers, this orchestra had organized concert tours to West Coast, Europe and Asia. The 7th Asia Tour was successfully accomplished in the summer of 2012, performed in concerts with Da-Feng Elementary School Orchestra of New Taipei City in Osaka and Taipei, under the conducting of Cheng-Wen Winnie Lai and Tze-Fu Liu.

Our mission is to provide the multicultural and orchestral experiences to talented and serious musical students age 10-18, with our unique repertories of Classical, Popular, Jazz, Film, Broadway and Asian Music. Many of our members are new immigrants, they are enthusiastic to learn the music in the US; as well as, some American-born 2nd and 3rd generation youngsters, who would like to know the music of their heritage. Our program is sponsored, in part by the Public Funds from the New York City Department of Cultural Affairs; other sponsors including: Culture Center & Taipei Cultural Center of Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in New York.

音樂總監:梁兆豐博士 Dr. Jeffrey Liang, Music Director



出生於台灣的指揮兼長號演奏家梁兆豐博士,先後畢業於紐約曼哈頓 音樂學院與耶魯大學音樂研究所,2002年於紐約州立大學石溪分校取 得音樂藝術博士學位。梁兆豐自1999年起擔任紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂 團之音樂總監,除多次指揮該團於紐約林肯中心演出外,也經常帶團 前往歐、美、亞各地巡迴表演,2006年更受邀至奧地利【莫扎特音樂 節】中指揮演出,也多次帶領幼獅走出音樂廳將音樂帶入醫院、養老 院、圖書館及社區中心等角落;此外,梁兆豐目前也受聘擔任震撼管 樂團之藝術總監兼指揮與台灣耶魯室內樂團指揮,曾多次參與外交部 【讓世界聽見台灣的聲音】計畫至美、亞洲多國為台灣音樂發聲。

梁兆豐的演出足跡遍及世界各地,包括有捷克、奧地利、美國、日 本、韓國、新加坡、菲律賓、馬來西亞、泰國、帛琉、台灣及中國大 陸。

對推廣現代作曲家不遺餘力的梁兆豐博士,曾於林肯中心發表多項首 演作品,合作過的作曲家包括有連信道、沈錦堂、康歐、陳建年、 James Cohn、Arthur Frackenpohl、Andrew Beall、Steven Huang等。

在指揮與演奏外,梁兆豐也熱衷於音樂教育,2008年曾受泰國皇家 Mahidol大學邀請擔任客座長號講師,目前受聘於台灣國立嘉義大學 音樂系擔任管弦樂團指揮與長號助理教授職務;此外,他也於天主教 私立光仁小學音樂班擔任管弦樂團與管樂團指揮、臺北市博愛國小與 中正高中管樂團指揮。

A native of Taiwan, conductor and trombonist Dr. Jeffrey Liang received his music training in the United States since age of 19, including Manhattan School of Music (BM), Yale University (MM), and State University of New York at Stony Brook (DMA).

Dr. Liang began his conducting career with Youth Orchestra, CYCNY in 1999. Over the years, he has brought the orchestra from a local ensemble to an internationally known orchestra. Besides its Annual Lincoln Center concert series, Dr. Liang has taken the orchestra on several tours to Europe and Asia, including 2006's Mozart Festival in Salzburg and Vienna. Together with Youth Orchestra CYCNY, Dr. Liang premiered many new works on the stage of Lincoln Center, including compositions of Arthur Frackenpohl, James Cohn, Andrew Beall, Steven Huang, Hsin-Tao Lien, Chin-Tang Shen, Oe Kang, and Chien-Nien Chen. As an international artist, Dr. Liang has performed in many countries around the world, including Czech Republic, Austria, Japan, Korea, Singapore, Philippine, Malaysia, Thailand, Palau, Taiwan, and China.

As a music educator, Dr. Liang has been teaching music in all levels for over 15 years. He is currently teaching at the music department of National Chiayi University in Taiwan, as both the orchestra conductor and trombone professor. Dr. Liang also serves as the conductor of Ta-Feng Elementary School Symphony, Guanjan Catholic School Orchestra, Zhung-Zheng Senior High School Wind Ensemble, Boai Elementary School Band, Shock Concert Band, and Taiwan Yale Ensemble.

指揮:鍾啓仁老師 Chijen Christopher Chung, Conductor

鍾啓仁老師除了敎學外並有豐富的 行政經驗[,] 曾擔任台灣中華民國音 樂敎育學會及民族音樂學會的秘 書,音契合唱管絃樂團的藝術行政



助理及紐約雅歌音樂藝術學院的音樂總監等。1997來美就讀Purchase College, SUNY並師事瓜內裡絃樂四重奏的大提琴 家Peter Wiley,並獲得音樂學士及音樂碩士學位。有數十年敎學及行政經驗的鍾啓仁老師2006年起擔任紐約幼獅青少 年管弦樂團弦樂指導,曾於2010年年度音樂會與本樂團合作擔任獨奏,於林肯中心愛麗斯特莉廳,熱情和精勘地演出 艾爾加大提琴協奏曲。2011年10月起擔任本團指揮,並在大紐約地區敎授大提琴及鋼琴。

A native of Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Christopher Chung began his musical studies in piano, violin and cello at the ages of five and nine. Following a successful musical career in high school, he attended the National Taiwan Normal University where he majored in cello and was awarded the Certificate of Music Education.

Upon moving to the United States, Mr. Chung studied under the tutelage of master cellist Peter Wiley (of the famed Guarneri String Quartet), at the prestigious Conservatory of Music at Purchase College, SUNY, where he received both his Bachelors and Masters Degree in Cello Performance.

In addition to his academic credentials, Mr. Chung's wide professional experience encompasses symphony orchestra and chamber music performances, conducting, teaching, studio recording and administration. He has served as Associate Principal Cellist of the Taipei Symphony Orchestra, Principal Cellist of the Yin-Qi Symphony Orchestra and Chorus and Principal Cellist of the Yin-Qi Chamber Orchestra in Taiwan. He has also performed with the Chinese Community Chamber Orchestra at Carnegie Hall, New York Symphony Orchestra and the Amadeus String Quartet and Piano Trio.

Mr. Chung's teaching positions include the Guang-Ren High School, Xi-Men Elementary School, Guan-Du Christian College in Taiwan and, in the United States, Music Director and cello and piano instructor at the Song of Songs Music School, Eastern School of Music and Amadeus Conservatory of Music. In 2003, he served as Director and featured cellist for the world premiere of an original Chinese-language adaptation of A Streetcar Named Desire at the Hwa-Sun Culture Center in Taipei, Taiwan.

A long-time string faculty member and this season's conductor of Youth Orchestra, CYCNY, Mr. Chung is proud to have performed with the orchestra as soloist in Elgar's Cello Concerto, at Alice Tully Hall in Lincoln Center.

Mr. Chung has long believed that music has the power to transform lives, to transcend cultures and languages and to bring people together in important and lasting ways. It is for this reason that he dedicates his life toward inspiring a new generation of young musicians to pursue their dreams through the challenging and life-changing process of music education.

打擊樂家林季靜,擁有市立大學打擊演奏碩士學位及Mannes School of Music 打 擊演奏家文憑。在台灣期間除了任敎於台北縣市多所國中高中之音樂班及管樂 團打擊指導老師之外,也多次和台北交響樂團,國家音樂廳交響樂團,台北愛 樂,台灣交響樂團及附設管樂團演出。在美期間,曾分別於2001及2002年擔任紐 約市立打擊音樂節之木琴獨奏演出,致力於交響樂團打擊演奏的林季靜多次擔 任樂團首席與多數知名指揮家,交響樂團及歌劇院於紐約各大音樂廳演出,多 次在林肯中心的 Avery Fisher Hall、Alice Tully Hall、Merkin Hall、 United Nation Conference Hall、卡內基音樂廳、紐約大都會歌劇院以及費城 Kimmel Center and Version Hall、華盛頓及紐澤西演出,也曾經與New York Asia Symphony Orchestra至東京的Suntory Hall,京都、大阪及廣島巡迴演出,也多次 與CYCNY於summer tour 至Taipei、China、Hong Kong and Japan演出。而熱愛現 代室內樂的林季靜也多次受邀演出知名作曲家譚盾、陳怡及Jennifer Hindon之作 品,並與紐約知名打擊樂四重奏Talujon Percussion Ensemble合作演出。目前與 多數交響樂團及歌劇院做定期之演出。

Taiwanese percussionist Chi-Ching Grace Lin is active as an orchestra, chamber and soloist in New York City area. Ms Lin performs with The Metropolitan Opera, DiCapo Opera, Teatro Grattacielo Opera, Binghamton Philharmonic, Riverside Symphony, National Choral, New Amsterdam Symphony Orchestra, New York Asian

Symphony Orchestra, Westfield Symphony Orchestra, Colonial Symphony and Park Chamber Symphony Orchestra in venues such as Lincoln Center, Carnegie Hall, Merkin Hall, Version Hall in Philadelphia, Washington DC and New Jersey. As soloist, Chi-Ching was feature as marimba soloist in the Day of Percussion Festival in New York City in 2001 and 2002 and also obtained the excellent performance of chamber ensemble award. In 2008 Chi-Ching premiered Andrew Beall's percussion concerto at Lincoln Center with CYCNY. She also can be found on Andrew Beall's solo percussion album "Deliverance". She has performed with the Talujon Percussion Quartet, Tam Dun Percussion group and 20th Center Contemporary Ensemble in NYC and Washington D.C. Before coming to United States Chi-Ching performed regularly with Taiwan National Symphony Orchestra, Taipei Symphony Orchestra, Taiwan Symphony and Taiwan Woodwind Ensemble. Chi-Ching received her Master's degree and Professional Studies Diploma from Queens College and Mannes College of Music where she studied percussion with Michael Lipsy, Michael Werner, Jim Priess, Barry Centanni and Glenn Valez. Chi-Ching is the percussion faculty of the Chinese Youth Orchestra of New York since 2006.

小號家張若葳先生3歲開始學習鋼琴,12歲起學習小號,2002年加入紐約幼獅青少年管弦樂團,曾先後演奏小提琴及大提琴,並於2006年起擔任小號首席。除多次於林肯中心演出外, 也曾多次隨團前往海內外演出,包括北京、上海、台北、大阪、香港、薩爾斯堡、維也納及 布拉格。張若葳目前就讀於曼哈頓音樂學院,小號師事於紐約愛樂管弦樂團小號演奏家 Thomas V. Smith及Vincent Penzerella。

Trumpeter Lovell Park Chang began his music studies at the age of three, initially studying on the piano. Since 2002, he began his study on the trumpet in sixth grade.

In 2002, he joined Youth Orchestra and played on the violin. Two years later, he played on the cello. In 2006, he has been playing on the trumpet for the remainder of the time spent with the Orchestra. Starting from the year 2005, he attended several summer concert tours with the orchestra, including Shanghai, Beijing, Taipei, Salzburg, Vienna, Prague, Osaka and Hong Kong.

He is currently attending Manhattan School of Music for his bachelors degree. He is Studying trumpet lessons with Thomas V. Smith, a member of the New York Philharmonic Orchestra. He also studied with Vincent Penzarella, a retired member of the New York Philharmonic.

Chiwei Chang is a member of the NAfME music teacher association who is currently dedicating his life to teaching piano,

strings, woodwinds and general music classes to kids and adults of all levels in Queens. Many parents have praised him for his ability to help students achieve outstanding scores on the NYSSMA and ABRSM instrumental exams under his supervision. Chiwei has directed a musical at Stony Brook University, trained singers ranging from the elementary school to the college level, and worked as a piano accompanist for live events and shows around New York. He has also conducted a number of concerts and composed music for ensembles performed at a number of venues, including Manhattan School of Music, Purchase College, and Hunter College. His most recent composition is a two movement piece titled "Algae on the Shores" for two violins, viola, cello, oboe, and the ocean.
